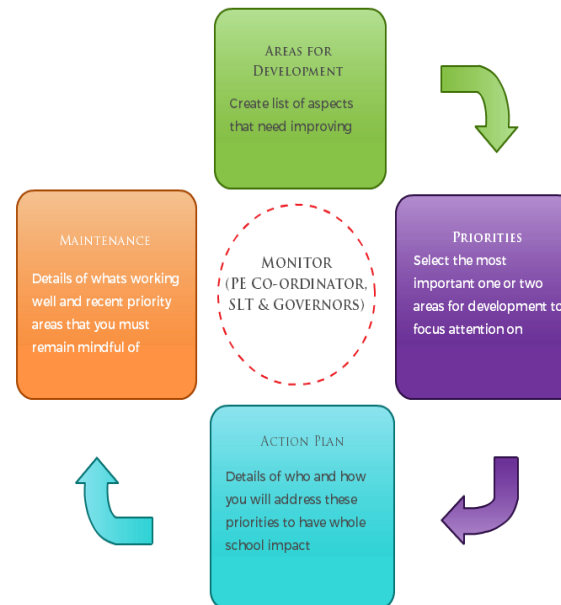


# Hawkes Farm Academy Sports Funding 2017/18
