<b>W h a l e</b>	A very large mammal that lives in the sea. Mammals that live in the sea are called cetaceans.
<b>M a   m m a l</b>	Mammals have a backbone and warm blood. Female mammals give birth to babies and feed their young with milk.
<b>S p e c i   e s</b>	A species is a group of animals with similar characteristics. There are 90 species of cetaceans.

<p>The blue whale is an endangered species. There is a risk that all living blue whales will die.</p> 	<p>The humpback whale has the conservation status of 'least concern' as the population of humpback whales is increasing. The humpback whale is not an endangered species.</p>
