


<p style="text-align: center;">ENGLISH</p> <p>CONTROLLED READING</p> <p>We will be reading 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King, in which the main character meets a Stone Age boy.</p>  <p>WRITING</p> <p>We will be writing in different genres focussing on developing our use of vocabulary, pronouns, prepositions, adverbs and paragraphs.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">MATHS</p> <p>We will be learning about shape, measures and statistics.</p> <p>Please encourage your child to log in to Times Table Rock Stars as often as possible to help them practice their times tables.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">TEXT AND CONTEXT</p> <p>Using the text Stig of the Dump, the children will be learning about life in the Stone Age.</p>  <p>At home, you can help by regularly looking at and discussing the information included in the Knowledge Organiser, which will be sent home in the next few days.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PHYSICAL EDUCATION</p> <p>PE takes place on Mondays for both classes. Over the Summer term, Mr Ellis will be teaching from a range of summer sports including rounders, stool ball and athletics.</p> <p>DAILY MILE</p> <p>The children are currently taking part in the Daily Mile which they are enjoying. They are running or walking for 15 minutes and enjoying racing each other for short periods and challenging themselves to run faster and further. Weekly certificates have now been introduced for pupils who show commitment to improvement.</p>

We will then move on to learning about light and then plants.</p>
